TREES KNOXVILLE CANOPIES FOR CAMPUSES PROGRAM GUIDELINES

Thanks for your interest in making Knox County schools greener! Here are some important things to know about participating in Canopies for Campuses.

- Before you reach out to us to nominate a school, please contact the school principal to get permission and gauge support for planting trees. School buy-in is critical for these projects to be successful.
- If you're not a teacher, principal, or staffer at the school, **identify a designated project** contact on the school staff. With their permission, of course!
- Trees Knoxville will collaborate with the school to scout locations and design the planting. We want your input—we'll walk the site and imagine all the possibilities together.
- From there, Trees Knoxville will coordinate the remaining steps of the project, including purchasing trees, working with maintenance staff, and securing volunteers to help on planting day. We strongly encourage students and teachers to join us as we plant!
- Plantings will be scheduled between November and March when trees are dormant.
- Watering the trees after planting is your responsibility. It isn't necessary to have a watering plan in place before you contact us, but in the organizational stage, we'll help you identify a committed group of volunteers, teachers, or students who will water at designated intervals.
- We'll do our best to accommodate all requests, but the timing of your planting may depend on capacity and funding.
